Sustainability

- POSITION 1 Modernize state and local laws to ensure housing opportunities are available, accessible, and affordable to all
- Actions range from State to local amendments, location of housing, jobs/ housing balance, fair share distribution, inclusionary housing, enabling design and accessibility, community engagement/ education

- POSITION 2 Preserve existing housing to maintain the quality and overall supply of affordable housing
- Actions aim to address market-rate affordable, deed-restricted affordable, monitoring affordability, and housing for older adults

- POSITION 3 Encourage environmental sustainability and resiliency as critical elements of housing availability and affordability.
- Actions address need to amend zoning and building requirements to increase production of net zero and passive homes. Education of tenants/ owners also addressed.

. POSITION 4 Ensure public and private finance keeps pace and innovates to support increased housing availability and affordability

Actions aim to address public financing and policies (federal), private financing and policies, innovative financing tools, improved federal coordination of programs, and improvements to local tax policy.

POSITION 5 Support funding and program flexibility to provide services, shelters, and permanent supportive housing for homeless individuals and families.

Actions direct planners to advocate for funding and resources to support those most in need.
