Metropolitan Planning Organizations, such as CMAP, are required to adopt regional plans every four years. As a part of the planning process, CMAP will develop a new [socioeconomic forecast](#). Staff are working with EBP and Moody's Analytics to project regional employment over the next 30 years. The forecast will be used to shape policy recommendations and as an input to CMAP travel models. EBP and Moody's will review the region's economic outlook as well as the major drivers and assumptions underlying the forecast, including those related to COVID-19 and changing work arrangements.

6.0 Climate multi-year implementation plan

CMAP has identified climate initiatives as a core focus area and is developing a work plan to implement ON TO 2050 recommendations regarding [climate mitigation](#) and [resilience](#) over the next 3-5 years. Staff will present on the projects included in the current work plan, as well as progress on identifying priority program elements for future years.

7.0 Fox River Corridor Plan LTA project

CMAP is working with McHenry County and the City of McHenry to develop a [corridor plan](#) that improves river-related commerce, natural resources, recreation, and public access to/on the river. The planning area spans four municipalities over a distance of eight miles from Burtons Bridge at Route 176 to Johnsburg at North Chapel Hill Road. Staff will provide a brief overview of the project and highlight the relationship between economic development and recreational use of the river as well as the need for water and natural resources protection.
