- 5.0 Mobility Recovery**  
CMAP has brought on a consultant to help the region understand the impacts of the COVID crisis on our mobility systems and to develop an actionable plan to keep the region on track to meet the goals of ON TO 2050. The work will look to mitigate a likely rebound in congestion, sustain the transit system beyond the recovery phase, and increase the overall resilience of the region’s multimodal transportation system. Staff will present on the initiation of this work.

- 6.0 Safety Planning and Capacity Building Assistance**  
The impacts of the pandemic on local governments have strained municipal capacity while declining revenues are making it especially difficult to plan for 2021 and beyond. Additionally, with traffic fatalities on the rise, CMAP is developing a Traffic Safety Action

Agenda that would address regional traffic safety in a comprehensive, equitable, data-driven and collaborative way.

In collaboration with the Regional Transportation Authority, CMAP is offering technical assistance services that takes these conditions into consideration. The focus of the 2021 Call is to support municipalities of high and very high need. Staff will give an overview of the 2021 Call offerings which includes local safety planning and three new programs launched under the Embedded Staff Planner (ESP) Program. Staff will also summarize recent activities of the ESP supported by the MacArthur Foundation.
