7.0 Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)

On December 27, 2020, Title IV of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) was enacted. This Act included a local government component that resulted in the allocation of \$42,647,247 to be programmed and managed by CMAP. Eligibility for these funds are similar to the STP funds distributed to the councils and CDOT on an annual basis. As such, CMAP has distributed these funds in a manner that is similar the annual STP-Local distribution process, as detailed in the attached memo. As noted in the memo, CMAP has also developed the attached guidance for the programming and active program management of these CRRSAA funds. Staff will provide highlights of the guidance and next steps for programming the \$5,330,928 allocated to this committee for project selection.
