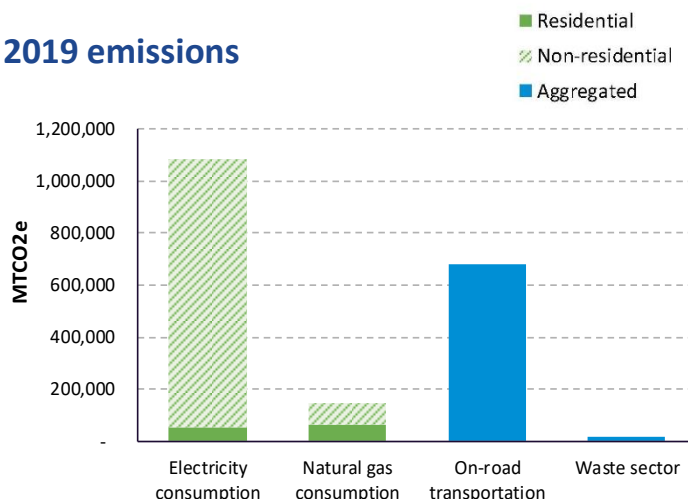

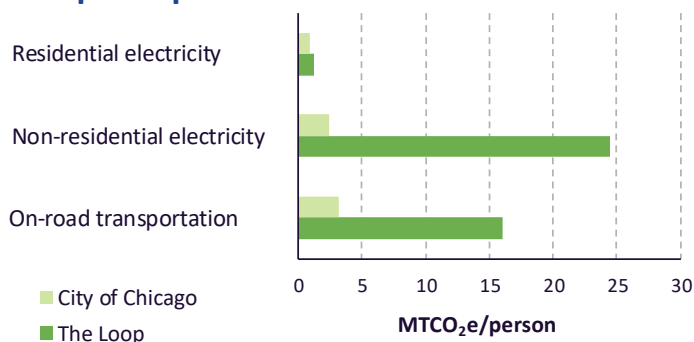

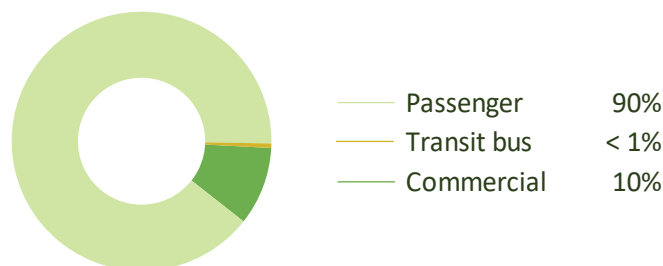
2019 emissions

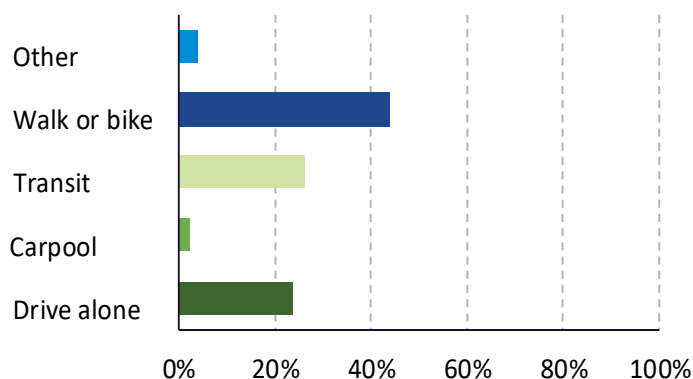
