TOPIC: Insights from CTA's 2007 Origin Destination Survey

ABSTRCT:

CTA conducted origin destination survey in summer 2007 to fulfill FTA's requirement that ridership and benefits estimation of New Starts projects proposed for preliminary engineering must be developed using a recent survey of riders of the existing transit system. The survey was conducted throughout CTA's system to cover corridors where New Starts projects are proposed and to develop a comprehensive dataset that can be used for other purposes as well. Approximately 100,000 paper surveys were distributed to CTA customers on 2,572 scheduled weekday trips (2,190 bus and 382 train trips) over a period of two months as they boarded their respective trains or buses. The questionnaire asked customers about various aspects of their CTA trip, including trip frequency, purpose, origin and destination, mode of access to CTA vehicle, boarding and exiting station, any transfers made during the course of the one-way trip, and various demographic questions. 34,102 surveys were received back from the riders, thus getting a response rate of 40%. The survey results are currently being used to update the New Starts model, validate CTA's internal rail origin destination model and understand travel patterns and customer behavior on proposed BRT routes. Findings from the survey will be presented and discussed.
