Definition of terms used in schedule

- *Visioning event* joint meeting of all CMAP working committees, coordinating committees, advisory committees, the Board of Directors, and the Metropolitan Planning Organization, as well as other partner agencies and elected officials
- Regional vision narrative description of the region's desired future characteristics in 2040, deriving from and building on the goal-setting processes for the 2040 Regional Framework Plan (Common Ground) and the 2030 Regional Transportation Plan
- Alternative scenarios possible future conditions based on combinations of implementation strategies; alternative scenarios will be evaluated to determine their effectiveness in meeting the regional vision *Scenario evaluation measures* measures derived from the regional vision that will be used to evaluate the effectiveness of alternative scenarios
- *Preferred scenario* the selected combination of implementation strategies (may be combinations of concepts from several scenarios) that is judged to best meet the regional vision
- *List of major capital projects* large capital projects that will be considered for specific reference within the plan
- Selection methodology for major capital projects quantitative and qualitative evaluation process that will be used to determine which major capital projects are most supportive of the preferred scenario
- Recommended policies, systems, and strategies specific strategies that are recommended to be implemented to achieve the preferred scenario
