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## **CMAQ Project Selection Committee** **November 15, 2007** Meeting Agreements

- 1) The Committee accepted the withdrawal of Schiller Park – Crystal Creek Ped Bridge and Sidewalk Improvements (TIP ID 04-06-0002).
- 2) The Committee accepted the withdrawal of Chicago Transit Authority – Chinatown/Pilsen Summer Shuttle (TIP ID 16-04-0003), and approved the increase to North/South Lake Shore Improvements and Marketing of CTA Service Improvements (TIP ID 16-04-0001) in the amount of \$101,738 federal, for a total federal cost of \$7,781,738.
- 3) The Committee approved the cost increase request for Kane County DOT – Randall Rd from Silver Glen Rd to Red Haw La (TIP ID 09-06-0004) and Randall Rd from Binnie Rd to IL 72 (TIP ID 09-06-0005) in the amount of \$443,201 federal for a combined CMAQ funding of \$1,334,361 federal (\$1,667,951 total).
- 4) The Committee approved the scope change request for North Chicago – IL 137/Sheridan Rd 10th St - 22nd St/MLKing Dr (TIP ID 10-04-0003), adding two additional signals in Waukegan to the project. The Committee also approved the cost increase request for this project in the amount of \$220,614 federal for total CMAQ funding of \$1,115,614 federal (\$1,394,517 total).
- 5) The Committee approved the cost increase request for CDOT – Bike Transit Connection (TIP ID 01-01-0013) in the amount of \$400,000 federal for total CMAQ funding of \$956,000 federal (\$1,195,000 total).
- 6) The Committee approved the draft FY 2009 CMAQ program development schedule, noting that a revision will be required once the meeting schedule for the Programming Coordinating Committee is established.
- 7) The Committee approved the proposed staff revisions to the CMAQ instructions and methods. In addition, the Committee directed that a separate diesel emissions reduction category be added to the CMAQ proposal classification scheme. The list of already-approved projects that involve outreach/promotional efforts will be included in the information booklet.
- 8) Staff will send to the Committee draft language for a letter notifying applicants of proposals with no benefit that their application will not be processed.

- 9) The Committee will discuss types of projects that may, or already do, receive 100% CMAQ funding at the next meeting. The list of projects currently receiving 100% CMAQ funding will be distributed to the Committee prior to that time.
- 10) The next CMAQ Project Selection Committee meeting will be left on call.
