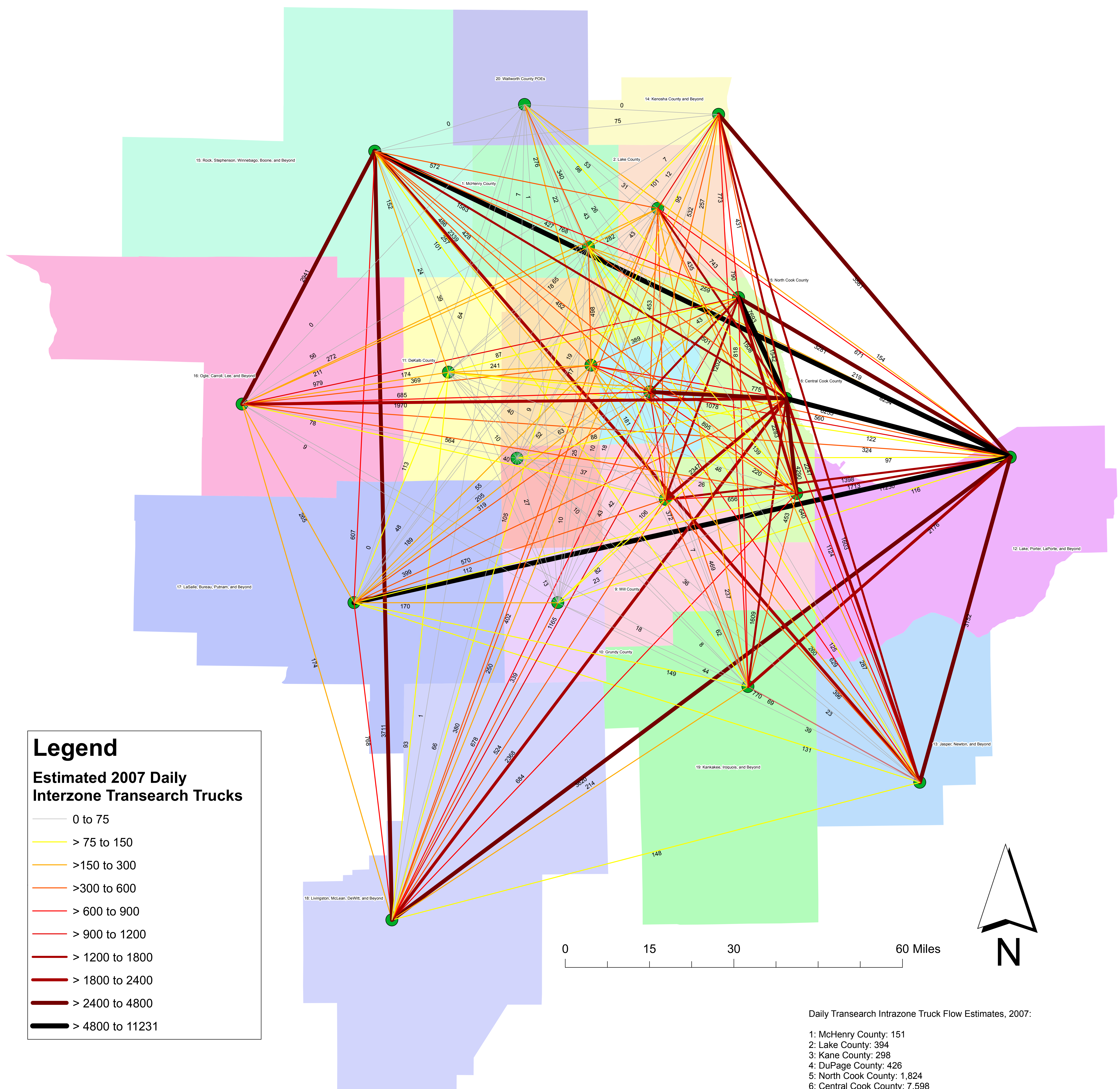


# Daily Transearch Interzone Truck Flow Estimates - 2007
