1.0 Call to Order/Introductions

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

3.0 Approval of Minutes—January 14, 2013

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented.

4.0 Regional 2-1-1 Update

Seth Kidder, Assessment and Planning Coordinator of Population Health Services at Lake County Health Department and Community Health Center, presented on the implementation of Lake County's community health improvement plan. This plan was developed out of the Mobilizing for Action through Planning and Partnerships (MAPP) process, a community-driven strategic planning process for improving community health. The MAPP process acknowledges that every aspect of community is related to the local public health system, including the public health department, employers, city planners, military, transit and faith institutions, to name a few.

Mr. Kidder offered examples of how the MAPP process has been implemented throughout Lake County. Lake County Health Department supplies health data and also helps steering committees to collect data at the local level. Data is then prioritized, along with a strategy to address health priority areas. For more information about Lake County's MAPP process, please see the presentation on the HCD webpage.

5.0 Developing a Health and Planning Workshop

CMAP staff Samantha Robinson and Bob Dean led a discussion about a future symposium, to be held at CMAP, which would focus on health and planning. Staff reminded the committee that CMAP would like to focus more on health in comprehensive plans. Given HCD's focus, the committee could be instrumental in shaping how CMAP links health and planning.

The HCD Committee would be instrumental in planning the logistics of the symposium. The symposium would bring together representatives from throughout the region, who work in planning, health, and transportation departments. Some of these individuals would share how they have successfully integrated health into various planning efforts. Others would learn how they could make this connection in the future.

This discussion was the first of several and was an opportunity to gather the committee's initial thoughts. In summary, the committee suggested the next steps for organizing the symposium: determine the workshop design; identify integration that would be beneficial to health, transportation and planning; pinpoint resources to fund and sustain this work; consider macro strategic changes as well as local strategies; and determine implementation and coordination.
