CMAP is working with Will County on the Moving Will County project, including a joint Truck Routing Study and Land Use Strategy, with a goal to achieve a balance between freight traffic, freight-generating land uses, new development, agriculture, natural and cultural resources, residential areas and other issues of community livability.

Representatives from the consultant team, including Ginkgo and Civiltech, will provide an overview of the land use scenario work so far, discuss next steps, and solicit feedback from committee members.
