#### **9.0 Indian Creek Watershed-based Plan – Holly Hudson, CMAP**

In collaboration with local partners, CMAP is developing a watershed-based plan for Indian Creek in the Lower Fox River Basin. The plan will identify planning, policy, outreach and education, and on-the-ground project recommendations that will help improve and protect water quality throughout the Indian Creek watershed as well as the downstream Fox River. The watershed resource inventory phase is nearing completion, and CMAP will be moving into the plan development phase over the winter including public engagement and BMP identification. Staff will provide a brief overview of the project to date and would like to hear the Committee’s ideas and suggestions toward effective virtual public engagement.
