Arlington Heights is hosting a public workshop June 19 to discuss the future of housing and the village needs the the public's opinions.

Arlington Heights, the last municipality to join the intergovernmental agreement with Palatine, Buffalo Grove, Mt. Prospect and Rolling Meadows, —created the Northwest Suburban Housing Collaborative. Together, the municipalities will pool together resources to address short- and long-term housing needs for Northwest Cook County.

Drew Williams-Clark, principal regional planner for the [Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning](#) or CMAP and Mary Lu Seidel, director of the [Northwest Suburban Housing Collaborative](#), gave a presentation at the village's Committee-of-the-Whole meeting, that highlighted housing needs for Arlington Heights in future years.

At the workshop, CMAP will present "[Homes for a Changing Region](#)," a report that includes housing forecasting, recommended strategies and analysis for market segmentation, workforce, sustainability and capacity.
