6.0 Overview of BRACE Illinois - Samuel Dorevitch, MD, MPH and Elena Grossman, MPH,

Over the past two decades, the state of Illinois has experienced a number of extreme weather events. As the climate grows warmer, these types of events and infectious disease are expected to increase. To prepare for climate change, Building Resilience Against Climate Effects (BRACE)-Illinois was designed to create a Climate and Health Adaptation Plan for the State of Illinois. BRACE-Illinois staff, Dr. Dorevitch and Ms. Grossman, will share about how in preparing for climate change there is also an opportunity to reduce associated adverse health impacts.
