
The request is for the following project:

The Madison Street project is a resurfacing project that is the second stage of a larger project running the entire length of Madison Street between the Village. The first phase is presently under construction. The McDermott Drive project is the result of several years of planning for a project originally set as a resurfacing but requiring a complete reconstruction. The project may slip to the March letting depending upon ongoing negotiations with landowners.
