

## **New Traffic Light Set For Next Year At River Road Blue Line Stop**

Motorists and pedestrians in the vicinity of River Road and the CTA Blue Line station in Rosemont will have an easier way to navigate next year.

Plans call for an upgraded traffic signal at the entrance to the CTA parking lot. A new crosswalk and other pedestrian aids will be included.

Rosemont Village Board members Wednesday authorized spending an amount not to exceed \$135,000 for the improvements. The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) will pay 80% of the total cost that's expected to exceed \$520,000.

Work on the project is expected to be done next year, according to Rosemont Mayor Brad Stephens.
