

# Bike racks to be added at Chicago-Main Street stops

**B**ike racks will be more plentiful around the [Metra](#) and [Chicago Transit Authority](#) (CTA) Chicago Avenue-Main Street stations under a resolution approved at the March 14 [Evanston](#) City Council meeting.

Aldermen approved a resolution authorizing the city manager to execute an agreement with the [Regional Transportation Authority](#) to use agency's grant money to install 40 bike racks at the station.

The \$70,000 in funding for the project came through a Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality of \$56,000 from the CTA and \$14,000 from the RTA, officials said in a memo.

Work on the project is expected to begin in late 2016 and finish early 2017, officials said.
