The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) and its partners have begun development of the ON TO 2050 comprehensive plan to build a more prosperous future and enhance the quality of life for the seven counties and 284 municipalities of northeastern Illinois, the release said.

For ON TO 2050, CMAP seeks the community's input and ideas about transportation systems, access to jobs, housing choices, preservation of natural areas, workable tax policies and opportunities for reinvestment.
