Brolley named to CMAP regional planning board

The chairmen of the Kane and Kendall County Boards have appointed Matt Brolley, Montgomery village president, to serve as the representative for the two counties on the governing board for the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP).

Brolley's appointment is effective through July 1, 2019.

His appointment was announced in a letter released by Chris Lauzen, chairman of the Kane County Board Oct. 5.

Lauzen wrote, "Kane County looks forward to our continued cooperation with CMAP and President Brolley's representation of Kane and Kendall counties on the CMAP Board."

Lauzen's letter was copied to John Shaw, Kendall County Board chairman.

Established in 2005 by the Illinois General Assembly, CMAP is responsible for comprehensive regional planning in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Kendall, Lake, McHenry and Will counties in northeastern Illinois.

Brolley has served as village president since 2013. Prior to that time, he was a member of the village's

plan commission.

The village is located in both Kane and Kendall counties.
