




What is a CEDS?

- A three county partnership to develop a joint plan for economic development
- Builds off a 2010 joint plan for Boone and Winnebago

A Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy for Boone, McHenry, and Winnebago Counties



Process

- January 2015 Kickoff project
- February–June 2015 Initial analysis, explore strategies
- July 2015 Public feedback on draft strategies
- August–November 2015 Create draft plan
- November-December 2015 Draft review
- January-February 2016 Adoption

Major issues/ Key findings

- More ways needed to speak and act as one
- While employers like the workforce, the region must confront long-term concerns
 - Education level
 - Growth/ migration
 - Age
- Land use decisions play a critical role in workforce and business attraction
- A strong manufacturing base across the three counties offers opportunities for future growth
- Challenging business environment

Key recommendations

- Speak and act with one voice
 - Regional plan commission
 - Collaborative site selection responses
 - Common business and workforce outreach efforts and data collection
 - Jointly advocate for priority infrastructure projects
- In-depth target industry analysis

Key recommendations

- Workforce issues
 - "Live here/work here" campaign
 - Link workforce and business development efforts
 - Support local housing diversity, particularly in downtowns
- Business environment
 - Advocate as one group at the state level
 - Tax-value proposition
 - Continue to maintain the County's urban/rural balance

Implementation

- A subset of 19 tactics to be implemented in 2016 and 2017
 - MCEDC already working with County staff to add these into the 2016 Action Plan
 - Subset includes actions such as:
 - The regional plan commission
 - Regional site selection responses
 - A common business and workforce outreach system
 - The in-depth target industry analysis
