The semi-annual GO TO 2040 and TIP conformity amendment is scheduled to be considered at the March meetings of the CMAP Board and MPO Policy Committee. The amendment was released for public comment at the Transportation Committee meeting on January 22, 2016. No comments were received on the conformity amendment.

- 5.0 Update to monthly and daily VMT inputs to MOVES model**
The MOVES model inputs for the monthly distribution of VMT by source type (vehicle type) and month, and the daily distribution of VMT by source type, month, road type and weekday vs. weekend were updated based on IDOT continuous count data, supplemented with other sources. The consultation team reviewed and concurred in the use of these data for MOVES runs; Illinois EPA requested additional time to review the updates, and concurred in their use via.
ACTION REQUESTED: Final concurrence in the use of the updated input data
- 6.0 Transition to MOVES2014a model**
The MOVES2014 model was released in July, 2014. Adoption of the model is mandatory two years after the release date. The next conformity analysis is anticipated to begin in June, 2016, with MOVES runs in early July. CMAP staff have been testing MOVES2014 in parallel with MOVES2010 over the past several conformity analyses; results show that the region conforms. Staff recommends using MOVES2014a to conduct the next conformity analysis.

ACTION REQUESTED: Concurrence in the use of MOVES2014a for the conformity analysis to be approved in October, 2016.

7.0 Ozone NAAQS Update

US EPA published a final rule updating the ozone NAAQS on October 26, 2015. The implementation timeline will be discussed.

10.0 Updated Transportation Conformity SIP

In 1998, the Illinois EPA finalized the attached Memorandum of Agreement on the process to conduct Transportation Conformity in the Chicago nonattainment area. This agreement was in the process of being approved for inclusion in the SIP. However, due to a March 1999 court ruling on a transportation conformity issue, the USEPA revised the conformity process which had been incorporated into the MOA, rendering the MOA unapprovable. The Illinois EPA would like to revisit the transportation conformity agreement and begin discussions with stakeholders in order to submit an updated transportation conformity plan.
