**2. Project Follow-up**

**A. CTA (TIP ID 16-96-0003)**

The CTA submitted emissions benefit data for the station improvements at the 47<sup>th</sup> Street station on the Red Line. A copy of the most recent information is attached.

**B. CDOT (TIP IDs 01-90-0008 & 01-94-0079)**

Staff is working with FTA to clarify the processes for reprogramming CMAQ funds in FTA grants and for handling de-obligated CMAQ funds.

**C. Sauk Trail Pedestrian Bridge (TIP ID 07-99-0007)**

The Village of Richton Park expects to select a phase-1 engineering consultant by May 29<sup>th</sup>. The committee had requested that funds be obligated by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

**D. Others**

The next projects for which deadlines were set are:

- Sauk Trail Road Project (Village of Richton Park, TIP ID 07-97-0023), for which phase-2 engineering funds are to be obligated by July 1<sup>st</sup>
- Salt Creek Greenway (DuPage County Forest Preserve District, TIP ID 08-96-0032), for which phase-2 engineering funds are to be obligated by July 1<sup>st</sup>. The consultant on this project has assured staff that this will be done.
