I. FY 2000 program mark and schedule

The preliminary FY 2000 mark is \$66.8 million federal. The \$3.1 million, \$2.9 million and \$3.2 million programmed for Franklin Park, Pace and Metra projects, respectively, are included in the \$66.8 million. A revised schedule culminating in Policy Committee consideration of the proposed program at its December 1999 meeting will be provided.

III. Project rankings and program development

The project rankings distributed to Committee members will be discussed. Three rankings are provided: cost per ton of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) eliminated, cost per 1000 vehicle miles traveled (VMT) eliminated, and cost per 1000 trips eliminated. The ranking sheets also indicate the CMAQ match percentage, which projects have had prior investments of CMAQ funds, and which projects are proposed for engineering only. Copies of the rankings will be available at the meeting.¹
