I. Options for CMAQ program development

The Work Program Committee will act on recommendations regarding future TIP development at its April 12 meeting. If the WPC approves the recommendations made by the TIP Procedures Committee, the CMAQ Committee will be asked to consider development of FY 98 and FY 99 programs. Project types to be included in the call for projects should also be considered. Discussion will include limiting the call for projects to exempt, conformed and non-regionally significant projects be accepted; whether demonstration projects will be accepted; and whether cost increases for programmed projects will be considered.

II. Fiscal guidelines

Proposed fiscal guidelines for the CMAQ program will be presented.

III. Application booklet

A revised CMAQ project application booklet is enclosed for review and approval.

IV. Status of programmed CMAQ projects

The committee reviews the status of programmed projects annually. A status report prepared by CATS staff on the demonstration projects is enclosed. Regarding capital projects, staff recommends that the transit implementors be asked to speak to the projects under their direction, and that IDOT address the status of its projects and the local projects being administered through the FHWA.
