

Survey Outreach


- Elected Officials and Municipal Staff were very responsive

- Every subregional council achieved a response rate of greater than 65%



Over the next two years, would you say that **producing a plan** is a priority for your government?




What type of plan(s)?







Over the next two years, is **developing a new or revising an existing Code or ordinance pertaining to land use, development, or transportation** a priority for your government?




What type of code or ordinance?







Over the next two years, would you say that training your staff, appointed, or elected officials is a priority for your government?










Over the next two years, would you say that **developing or updating a capital improvement program/plan (CIP)** is a priority for your government?







Over the next two years, would you say that **applying for grant funding to support plan implementation** is a priority for your government?







Over the next two years, would you say that **attracting development to a specific site** is a priority for your government?






Over the next two years, would you say that outreach to residents/public engagement is a priority for your government?
