For the first time in its history, MWRD has hired a master planning team to create a vision plan for a community (Robbins) that will use green

infrastructure to not only remove severe flooding problems but also create a significant amenity of natural beauty (Robbins Park and wetlands). The Executive Director of MWRD will discuss this complex, groundbreaking project that involves land development of scale and capacity-enhancing partnerships.

8.0 ON TO 2050: Pilot Layers – Evy Zwiebach and Brian Daly, CMAP

Using data layers and mapping, alongside pertinent local recommendations, will be a key method for translating ON TO 2050's regional policies to the local level. Staff will review progress made on these products and ask for the Committee's feedback on the overall approach.
