By 2050, automated vehicles and other emerging technologies are poised to have transformational impacts of similar magnitude. CMAP staff are preparing a strategy paper that explores recent developments and possible future impacts of emerging technologies with the potential to affect land use, travel patterns, economic activity, governance and quality of life, including, connected vehicles and smart infrastructure, automated vehicles, shared mobility, big data, and alternative energy. Staff will present on the draft strategies under discussion.
