- 4.0 **ON TO 2050: Transit Trends Snapshot** – Elizabeth Irvin, CMAP
Staff will present findings from a recent ON TO 2050 [snapshot](#), which highlights data on regional transit use, performance measures, and investment. Understanding these trends will help the region plan to meet our goal to increase ridership significantly. The report assesses three fundamental performance measures: speed, reliability, and frequency.

- 5.0 **Transportation in Economically Disconnected Areas** – Liz Schuh, CMAP
Staff will discuss findings from forthcoming Policy Updates that explore characteristics of the region’s economically disconnected areas, with an emphasis on their transportation challenges. This analysis will help to advance CMAP’s efforts to understand and articulate the policy needs related to the ON TO 2050 principle of inclusive growth.

- 6.0 **Job market polarization in metropolitan Chicago** – Diana Cooke, CMAP
Staff will provide an update on recent CMAP analysis of job market polarization in northeastern Illinois. Published research suggests that since 1980, employment growth nationwide has occurred primarily in high-income and low-income occupations, accompanied by an erosion of those in the middle. Evidence of similar trends in the region would help to inform strategies for future economic opportunity and growth.
ACTION REQUESTED: Discussion
- 7.0 **Regional Strategic Freight Direction** – Liz Schuh and Tom Murtha, CMAP
Staff will present the draft [Regional Strategic Freight Direction](#) for discussion. The report provides near term direction for CMAP and key

partners in its freight planning, policy, and programming work. Freight Committee and other CMAP working committees have helped develop these recommendations over the past year. The document is supported by the [ON TO 2050 Freight Snapshot](#), which reviews data and trends in the region's goods movement system.

8.0 Expressway Vision – Tom Murtha, CMAP

Staff will provide an update on the development of a multi-jurisdictional vision to guide future capital investments, coordinate transportation operations, and recommend policy and management strategies for the existing expressway system in northeastern Illinois. Transit, freight, community impacts, and revenue will all be key aspects of the vision.

9.0 ON TO 2050: Layers Approach – Lindsay Bayley, CMAP

In developing ON TO 2050, CMAP aims to provide actionable guidance for local implementers of policy recommendations. CMAP developed the place-based layers approach to deliver contextual data on how strategies relate to local communities. CMAP staff will update the committee on the layers approach and give more information on the data layers that most directly relate to economic development and governance.
