


Five Referendum Questions Slated for Kendall Co. Ballot This November

Kendall County's five referendum questions for the November ballot are set.

The county ballot is similar to Grundy County's ballot. Referendum items include the one percent county-wide school facilities sales tax which was approved by Oswego SD308.

Two advisory referenda are on the ballot from the Kendall County Board.

The first question is in response to a proposal by the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) to levy a vehicle mileage tax on all motorists in the seven-county Chicago area. The question asks if Kendall County should voice opposition.

The second question asks voters whether the county should oppose the Federal Reserve's proposal to create a one per cent statewide property tax to fund Illinois' pension programs.

Some residents will also see two other school district referendum questions.

Saratoga School District 60C which is a Kindergarten through 8th Grade district that borders into both Kendall and Grundy Counties is asking district residents to approve a proposition to issue \$10.3 Million in building bonds.

The referendum is for building improvements and facility construction of a combined auditorium and cafeteria space, a learning resource center and additional classrooms.

Minooka School District #201 in Kendall, Grundy and Will Counties is also trying again for a referendum.

In March 2018, an initial referendum failed to gain voter approval so the school board voted to revise the question to only include the 5th through 8th grade school to address the existing and immediate need.

The total cost for the project, according to Superintendent Kris Monn, is estimated at \$50 million based on detailed estimates provided by Gilbane Construction. In addition to a new building, the passage would include a roadway construction to the east of the school.
