1.0 Call to Order and Introductions

Kyle Smith, acting chair, called the meeting to order at approximately 9:05 a.m.

2.0 Agenda Changes and Announcements

No changes were made to the circulated agenda.

3.0 2018 LTA Call for Projects

Tony Manno gave an overview of the 2018 call for projects for the Local Technical Assistance program. Committee members asked how many and what type of projects will be funded this year. CMAP staff explained that there will be fewer projects selected this year than last year, and that projects that support the implementation goals of ON TO 2050 will be prioritized.

4.0 ON TO 2050: Public Comment Draft

Liz Schuh presented the draft version of the ON TO 2050 long range comprehensive plan, including principles, goals, and implementation strategies. Committee members provided feedback on draft plan graphics and also inquired about the data collection surrounding

the change in multi-family housing units throughout the region. Members asked if data was skewed by the city of Chicago or if the data were broken down by type of multi-unit housing and whether trends could be broken down between pre-and post-2008 development. Members then highlighted findings from [Missing Middle](#) advocates as a contrasting view. CMAP Staff explained that the regional trend holds for the increase in multi-unit housing throughout the region and that data was not explicitly broken down by type of multi-unit housing. Committee members commented on mobility goals for the region, and commented positively on the plan as a whole, especially the importance of images to communicate points visually.

5.0 ON TO 2050: Implementation Priorities

Drew Williams-Clark gave an overview of the implementation priorities from ON TO 2050, including potential partners and steps to be taken to ensure implementation. Committee members requested clarification on the Chicago Regional Growth Corporation (CRGC) and inquired about implementation priorities for public transportation. CMAP Staff explained the role of the CRGC as a regionwide coordinator of economic development initiatives and identified priorities where public transportation will be involved.

6.0 ON TO 2050: Launch Event

Mandy Burrell informed committee members of the ON TO 2050 launch event, scheduled for October 10, 2018 at Millennium Park. Committee members inquired about accessibility accommodations, including captioning accommodations.

7.0 Other Business

Committee members discussed a potential security issue at a YMCA housing facility and how to best approach the problem. They also further discussed accommodations at the launch event.

8.0 Approval of Minutes – May 17, 2018

The members present unanimously approved the minutes from the previous meeting.

9.0 Public Comment

Members of the public commented on new housing both in Chicago and the suburbs that consists of many single family homes and homes with front stairs and the accessibility issues that accompany these homes. They also commented on the reliability of paratransit service in the suburbs.

10.0 Next Meeting

The Housing Committee meeting was scheduled for September 20, 2018.
