

Questions Log – Call for Transportation Projects webinar: Using eTIP to compete applications – January 17, 2019

Q: Please spend some time explaining details of the "Local match" requirements.

A: A minimum of 20% local (non-federal) match is required for all programs. The program application books have more details regarding these requirements.

Q: where can you locate your agency GATA number?

A: Your agency would get one from the State if you receive funds directly through them. Projects processed through FTA do not require GATA registration.

Q: Kama stated FFY should be different for each phase. Couldn't Phase 2 and ROW technically happen within the same FFY?

A: Yes, technically they could, so that would be an exception in rare cases.

Q: For intersection projects that only are an intersection of 2 roads, would you only fill in the local route as the main roadway and the primary cross street and leave the secondary cross street blank?

A: [CORRECTED] The preference is to enter the primary street in the primary field and the secondary street in the secondary field, leaving the local name field blank.

Q: Will PLs be automatically notified when a project is submitted for their review?

A: Yes, the PLs will receive an email and so will CMAP staff. [ADDITION: Notification is based on the project's Lead Agency selection]
