

## LAND USE AND HOUSING COMMITTEE DRAFT WORK PLAN

### Committee Charge

Provides feedback on CMAP projects relating to land use and housing, and serves to coordinate and prioritize policy positions, programs, and advocacy between CMAP and other organizations.

### Scoping background

The following is an outline of topics for the Land Use and Housing Committee meetings in 2019. Many work plan items will be determined closer to the meeting date. Feedback on committee activities received during the March meeting will inform subsequent meeting agendas. The agenda items will consider CMAP projects as well as committee member and partner initiatives that help push forward ON TO 2050 implementation.
